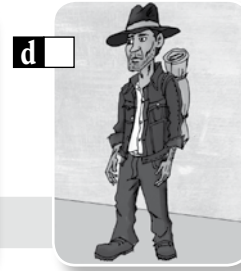
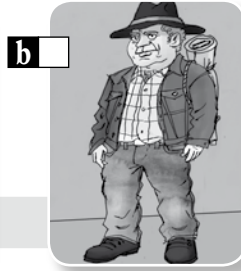
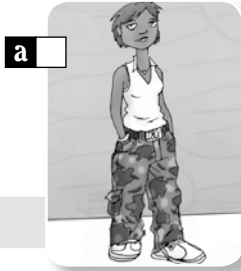


#### 1 Look at the pictures. Match the descriptions to the people.
